

FIREHOUSE BIKE TRIP · JUNE 21-28, 2020

INDIANA, KENTUCKY, TENNESSEE, GEORGIA



DAY 01 Seymour, IN to Corydon, IN

This scenic 74-mile tour through southern Indiana crosses over the longest covered bridge in America and finishes in Indiana's first capital.

DAY 02 Corydon, IN to Hodgenville, KY

A 78-mile trek across the Ohio River, into Kentucky, with a visit to the birthplace of President Abraham Lincoln.

DAY 03 Hodgenville, KY to Glasgow, KY

A 65-mile jaunt through central Kentucky that cuts through the eastern boundaries of Mammoth Cave National Park.

DAY 04 Glasgow, KY to Livingston, TN

A 66-mile cruise across southern Kentucky and into the foothills of Tennessee.

DAY 05 Livingston, TN to Spring City, TN

A 67-mile journey that drops into the drowsy shores of Watts Bar Lake.

DAY 06 Spring City, TN to Calhoun, GA

Finish up your adventure with a downhill century as we say goodbye to the mountains and say hello to the state of Georgia.

MARCH 8 @ NOON: PRE-BIKE TRIP MEETING

If you're thinking about joining us for this year's bike trip, make sure to attend this important meeting at the Firehouse Campus where we'll cover all of the details about what you'll need and how to get signed up! Bring your parents with you.

APRIL 12: TRAINING RIDES BEGIN

We'll kickoff our spring training rides on Sunday, April 12 at 2:00 p.m. Training rides depart from Doug Fecher's house on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. As always, you'll need to log 150 team miles to qualify for Bike Trip, but more miles is always better!

JUNE 7: BIKE TRIP QUALIFICATION DEADLINE

All riders must be qualified by sundown on June 7 in order to be a part of Bike Trip. If you need a few extra rides, it's not a big deal. Just let us know and we'll be happy to help you out!

JUNE 21: BIKE TRIP BEGINS

We'll meet the morning of June 21 at Firehouse where we'll pack up and worship together. In the afternoon, we'll drive to Seymour, IN and we'll begin riding the next morning.

JUNE 28: RETURN TO SOUTH BEND

We'll drive home from Calhoun, Georgia and arrive at the Firehouse Campus in the evening on June 28.

WHO CAN GO ON BIKE TRIP?

Bike Trip is designed for high school students, college students, and adults. If you will have completed the ninth grade by June 21, 2020; you're invited and encouraged to join us!

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A ROAD BIKE?

We have had some success finding road bikes to loan to first-year cyclists who cannot purchase a bike of their own. We can't make any promises, but email Aaron and he'll try to hook you up!

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

\$125 covers transportation, food, and everything else you'll need for the week. Bring discretionary cash for souvenirs, fast food, or stops for ice cream and coffee along the way

We'll sleep every night at a different church and we usually have plenty of time for exploration and adventure in town.
